A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$286-61 Penalty. (a) Any person who violates sections
- 4 [286-41,] 286-42, 286-44.5 to 286-56.5, and 286-58 to 286-60
- 5 shall be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$1,000[+].
- 6 (b) Any person who violates section 286-41 shall be fined
- 7 not less than \$100 and not more than \$2,000; provided that any
- 8 corporate owner of a motor vehicle who fails to register a motor
- 9 vehicle as required by section 286-41(a) following a transfer of
- 10 the vehicle between counties shall be fined \$1,000 for each
- 11 violation.
- 12 (c) Any person who violates section 286-43, 286-44, or
- 13 286-57 shall be fined not less than \$5 and not more than \$1,000
- 14 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 286-136, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$286-136 Penalty. (a) Except as provided in subsection
- 18 (b), any person who violates section 286-102, 286-122, 286-130,



- 1 286-131, [286-132,] 286-133, or 286-134 shall be fined not more
- 2 than \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both.
- 3 [Any] Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d), any person
- 4 who violates any other section in this part shall be fined not
- 5 more than \$1,000.
- 6 (b) Any person who is convicted of violating section 286-
- 7 102, 286-122, 286-130, 286-131, [286-132,] 286-133, or 286-134
- 8 shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$500 and a maximum fine of
- 9 \$1,000, or imprisoned not more than one year, or both, if the
- 10 person has two or more prior convictions for the same offense in
- 11 the preceding five-year period.
- (c) Any person who violates subsection 286-132 shall be
- 13 fined not more than \$2,000 or imprisoned not more than thirty
- 14 days, or both.
- (d) Any person who is convicted of violating section 286-
- 16 132 shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$1,000 and a maximum
- 17 fine of \$2,000, or imprisoned not more than one year, or both,
- 18 if the person has two or more prior convictions for the same
- 19 offense in the preceding five-year period.
- 20 [(c)] (e) Notwithstanding subsections (a) [and (b),] through
- 21 (d), a minor under the age of eighteen under the jurisdiction of
- 22 the family court who is subject to this section shall either

- 1 lose the right to drive a motor vehicle until the age of
- 2 eighteen or be subject to a fine of \$500."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
