A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OCEAN RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Pohoiki Bay on the
- 2 island of Hawaii is an attraction for commercial boat tours to
- 3 view lava flows, a source of livelihood for fishers, and an
- 4 important cultural and recreational site for many local
- 5 residents. There are user conflicts among the commercial boat
- 6 tours, fishers, and the non-commercial users of Pohoiki Bay.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to direct the department of land
- 8 and natural resources to study the Pohoiki Bay area to resolve
- 9 the conflicts among Native Hawaiians exercising gathering and
- 10 subsistence rights, recreational users, and commercial boat
- 11 tours and fishers using Pohoiki Bay.
- 12 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 13 shall conduct a study of Pohoiki Bay on the island of Hawaii for
- 14 the purpose of resolving the conflicts among commercial boat
- 15 tours and fishers, individuals exercising gathering and
- 16 subsistence rights, and recreational users at Pohoiki Bay. The
- 17 study shall evaluate:

1	(1)	Current rules and regulations applicable to commercial
2		tour boats and fishing at Pohoiki Bay;
3	(2)	The magnitude of use of Pohoiki Bay;
4	(3)	Ocean-based recreation and coastal area programs; and
5	(4)	Any other matters relevant to resolving the conflict
6		among Native Hawaiians exercising traditional
· 7		gathering and subsistence rights, recreational users,
8		and commercial tour boats and fishers that use Pohoiki
9		Bay.
10	SECTION 3. The department of land and natural resources	
11	shall submit a report of its study, including findings,	
12	recommendations, and any proposed legislation, to the	
13	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of	
14	the regular session of 2015.	
15	SECTION 4. The department of land and natural resources	
16	shall expend so much of the royalties it receives from	
17	geothermal resource mining leases as is necessary to establish	
18	and maintain one conservation enforcement officer position in	
19	the division of conservation and resource enforcement for the	
20	area of Pohoiki Bay on the island of Hawaii.	

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:
