# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOVIE THEATERS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 347-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"§347-13 Persons who are blind, visually handicapped, 3 disabled; public places; public conveyances. (a) Persons who 4 are blind, visually handicapped, or otherwise disabled are 5 entitled to full and equal accommodations, advantages, 6 facilities, and privileges of all common carriers, airplanes, 7 motor, vehicles, railroad trains, motor buses, street cars, 8 boats, or any other public conveyances or modes of 9 10 transportation, hotels, lodging places, places of public accommodation, amusement, or resort, and other places to which 11 the general public is invited, subject only to the conditions 12 and limitations established by law and applicable to all 13 14 persons.

(b) Every person who is blind, deaf, visually handicapped, or otherwise disabled shall have the right to be accompanied by a service dog, especially trained for the purpose of assisting the person in any of the places listed in subsection (a) without HB LRB 14-0441-1.doc Page 2

1	being required to pay an extra charge for the service dog;
2	provided that the person shall be liable for any damage done to
3	the premises or facilities by the service dog. No service dog
4	shall be considered dangerous merely because it is unmuzzled.
5	(c) Every disabled person shall have the right to use a
6	life jacket or other flotation device in a public swimming pool;
7	provided that:
8	(1) The person suffers from a physical disability or
9	condition that requires the use of a life jacket or
10	other flotation device; and
11	(2) The person obtains a statement signed by a licensed
12	physician or physician assistant attesting to the
13	person's need to use a life jacket or other flotation
14	device.
15	(d) Every motion picture theater to which the general
16	public is invited shall provide closed captioning and
17	descriptive narration of each motion picture being shown.
18	[ <del>(d)</del> ] <u>(e)</u> The director of human services shall adopt rules
- 19	pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this
20	section."
