## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
3	"(a) There is established within the department the		
4	teacher national board certification incentive program to		
5	recognize and support exemplary teaching practice by supporting		
6	public school teachers who have achieved national board		
7	certification under the certification program of the National		
8	Board for Professional Teaching Standards. The teacher national		
9	board certification incentive program shall provide:		
10	(1) A \$5,000 bonus per year for each public school teacher		
11	who maintains current national board certification;		
12	(2) \$1,500 upon completing the certification program of		
13	the National Board for Professional Teaching		
14	Standards;		
15	(3) A reimbursement of the remainder of the national board		
16	certification application fee upon achievement of		
17	national board certification; and		

1	(4) An a	dditional \$5,000 bonus per year for each public
2	scho	ol teacher who maintains current national board
3	cert	ification and who teaches at:
4	(A)	[A school that is in restructuring under the No
5		Child Left Behind Act, Public Law-107-110; A
6		school in a focus, priority, or superintendent's
7		zone, or other similar designation, as determined
8		by the department;
9	(B)	A school with a high turnover rate, as determined
10		by the department; or
11	[ <del>(C)</del>	A school that is not making adequate yearly
12		progress, but is not in restructuring under the
13		No Child Left Behind Act, Public Law 107-110; or
14	<del>(D)</del> ]	(C) A hard-to-fill school, as determined by the
15		department."
16	SECTION 2	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 3	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
