# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLEMNIZATION OF MARRIAGE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 572-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 Marriages, reported by whom. It shall be the duty of "(b) 4 every person, legally authorized to perform the marriage 5 ceremony, to report within three business days every marriage 6 ceremony, performed by the person, to the agent of the department of health in the district in which the marriage takes 7 8 place setting forth all facts required to be stated in a 9 standard certificate of marriage, the form and contents of which 10 shall be prescribed by the department of health [; provided that 11 if any person who has solemnized a marriage fails to report it 12 to the agent of the department of health, the parties married 13 may provide the department of health with a notarized affidavit 14 attesting to the fact that they were married and stating the 15 date and place of the solemnization of the marriage. -- Upon-the 16 receipt of that affidavit by the department of health, the marriage shall be deemed to be valid as of the date of the 17

1 solemnization of the marriage stated in the affidavit; provided
2 that the requirements of section 572-1 are met]."
3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken.
