RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a viable agriculture 2 industry requires a steady, reliable supply of water. However, 3 drought conditions continue to adversely affect Hawaii's farms and ranches, hampering the State's ability to produce quality 5 products on a consistent basis throughout the year. 6 The legislature believes that to address the harmful impact 7 of droughts, mitigation measures must be implemented. 8 state level, the Hawaii drought plan is aimed at developing 9 coordinated emergency response mechanisms while at the same time 10 outlining short-term and long-term steps toward mitigating the
- 11 impact of drought occurrences. In 2004, county drought
- 12 committees were formed in each of the four counties. The
- 13 purpose of these committees is to develop drought mitigation
- 14 strategies that address the local needs and concerns of each
- 15 county which are then incorporated by reference into the Hawaii
- 16 drought plan.
