

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDHOOD OBESITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§302A- (a) Beginning January 1, 2014, beverages other		
5	than water, milk, or one hundred per cent fruit juices shall not		
6	be sold to a pupil at an elementary school.		
7	(b) An elementary school may permit the sale of beverages		
8	that do not comply with subsection (a) as part of a school		
9	fundraising event in any of the following circumstances:		
10	(1) The items are sold by pupils of the school and the		
11	sale of those items takes place off the premises of		
12	the school; and		
13	(2) The items are sold by pupils of the school and the		
14	sale of those items takes place one-half hour or more		
15	after the end of the schoolday.		
16	(c) Beginning January 1, 2014, from one-half hour before		
17	the start of the schoolday to one-half hour after the end of the

12	<u>(1)</u> Off	the premises of the school; and
13	(2) One	-half hour or more after the end of the schoolday.
14	(e) Thi	s section does not prohibit an elementary, middle,
15	or intermedia	te school from making available through a vending
16	machine any b	everage allowed during the schoolday under
17	subsection (a) or (c) at any time of day; provided that no other
18	beverages sha	ll be sold in any vending machine on school
19	property.	
20	(f) For	the purposes of this section, "added sweetener"
21	means any add	itive that enhances the sweetness of the beverage,
22	including but	not limited to added sugar, but does not include
