A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that with the relocation
2	of the Honolulu fire department engine twenty-four, which
3	services Ewa Beach, its response times to certain areas may be
4	lengthened. The legislature also finds that the prior location
5	of engine twenty-four is an ideal one for an ambulance service.
6	By triangulating first responders and emergency medical
7	services, the Ewa Beach area would realize improved access to
8	emergency medical care and ambulance services.
9	The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds to
10	the department of health to demolish the Ewa Beach fire facility
11	and construct a LEED certified emergency medical services
12	facility at the same location.
13	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,750,000 or so much
15	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the
16	demolition of the Ewa Beach fire station (TMK 9-1-025-062) and


