## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1  | SECTION 1. The legislature finds that with the relocation        |

| 2  | of Honolulu fire department engine twenty-four, which services   |
| 3  | Ewa Beach, its response times to certain areas may be            |
| 4  | lengthened. The legislature also finds that the prior location   |
| 5  | of engine twenty-four is ideal for an ambulance service. By      |
| 6  | triangulating first responders and emergency medical services,   |
| 7  | the Ewa Beach area will realize improved access to emergency     |
| 8  | medical care and ambulance services.                             |
| 9  | The legislature further finds that Makalei area is               |
| 10 | presently without an ambulance service and that providing        |
| 11 | ambulance services is essential to providing life-saving medical |
| 12 | response services to West Hawaii.                                |
| 13 | The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds:         |
| 14 | (1) To the department of health to demolish the Ewa Beach        |
| 15 | fire facility and construct an energy-efficient and              |
| 16 | environmentally-sustainable emergency medical services           |
| 17 | facility at the same location; and                               |

- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for

- 7 and the construction of an energy-efficient and environmentally-
- 8 sustainable emergency medical services facility at the same

- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general

- 16 2014-2015 for the establishment of an ambulance service at the

- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 19 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
