A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:
"§663- Noise; private nuisance; relief. (a) A person
who alleges the existence of a private nuisance due to excessive
noise may bring a civil action for appropriate injunctive
relief, or actual damages, or both within two years after the
occurrence of the alleged violation of this part.
(b) An action commenced pursuant to subsection (a) may be
brought in the circuit court for the circuit where the alleged
violation occurred, where the complainant resides, or where the
person against whom the civil complaint is filed resides or has
a principal place of business.
(c) For purposes of this section:
"Damages" means damages for injury or loss caused by
excessive noise or vibration, including reasonable attorney

         "Nuisance" means any interference with reasonable use and
