A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INTERNET PRIVACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

7	(B) Is written in capital letters equal to or greater
8	in size than the surrounding text; and
9	(C) Is written in larger type than the surrounding
10	text, or in contrasting type, font, or color to
11	the surrounding text of the same size, or set off
12	from the surrounding text of the same size by
13	symbols or other marks that call attention to the
14	language; or
15	(4) Any other functional hyperlink that is so displayed
16	that a reasonable person would notice it.
17	"Consumer" means any individual who seeks or acquires, by
18	purchase or lease, any goods, services, money, or credit for
19	personal, family, or household purposes.
20	"Operator" means any person or entity that owns a website
21	located on the Internet or an online service that collects and
22	maintains personally identifiable information from a consumer

residing in the State who uses or visits the website or online 1 2 service if the website or online service is operated for commercial purposes. The term "operator" shall not include any 3 third party that operates, hosts, or manages, but does not own, 4 5 a website or online service on the owner's behalf or by 6 processing information on behalf of the owner. 7 "Personally identifiable information" means individually identifiable information about an individual consumer collected 8 9 online by the operator from that individual and maintained by 10 the operator in an accessible form, including any of the 11 following: 12 (1) A first and last name; 13 (2) A home or other physical address, including street name and name of a city or town; 14 15 (3) An e-mail address; A telephone number; 16 (4) 17 (5) A social security number; Any other identifier that permits the physical or 18 (6) online contacting of a specific individual; or 19

3	§481B-B Internet privacy. (a) An operator of a commercial		
4	website or online service that collects personally identifiable		
5	information through the Internet about individual consumers		
6	residing in the State who use or visit its commercial website or		
7	online service shall conspicuously post its privacy policy on		
8	its website or, in the case of an operator of an online service,		
9	make that privacy policy available in accordance with any other		
10	reasonably accessible means of making the privacy policy		
11	available for consumers of the online service.		
12	(b) The privacy policy under subsection (a) shall require		
13	the operator to do all of the following:		
14	(1) Identify the categories of personally identifiable		
15	information that the operator collects through the		
16	website or online service about individual consumers		
17	who use or visit its commercial website or online		
18	service and the categories of third-party persons or		
19	entities with whom the operator may share that		
20	personally identifiable information;		
21	(2) If the operator maintains a process for an individual		
22	consumer who uses or visits its commercial website or		

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1		online service to review and request changes to any of
2		the individual consumer's personally identifiable
3		information that is collected through the website or
4		online service, provide a description of that process;
5	(3)	Describe the process by which the operator notifies
6		consumers who use or visit its commercial website or
7		online service of material changes to the operator's
8		privacy policy for that website or online service; and
9	(4)	Identify the effective date of the operator's privacy
10		policy.
11	§ 481	B-C Violation. An operator shall not be deemed in
12	violation	of this part unless the operator fails to post its
13	policy wi	thin thirty days after being notified of noncompliance.
14	An operat	or who violates this part shall be guilty of a
15	violation	under section 480-2."
16	SECT	ION 2. In codifying the new sections added by section
17	1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute	
18	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating	
19	the new s	ections in this Act.
20	SECT	TON 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
