- 12 (b) In addition to any other terms or conditions required
- 13 by law, any contract between the authority and any state agency,
- 14 office, department, or other administrative subdivision shall
- 15 contain the following:
- 16 (1) A termination date;
- 17 (2) A statement of intent and purpose;
