RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- School gardens. (a) All schools may grow food
5	in school gardens for consumption in their school meals
6	programs; provided that food products used in a school meals
7	program shall be inspected and certified as safe by the
8	department of agriculture.
9	(b) Upon request by a school, a nonprofit organization, as
10	defined in section 302D-1, may establish and administer a fresh
11	food distribution service.
12	(c) The department may adopt rules under chapter 91 to
13	implement this section.
14	(d) The department shall not be liable to any person for
15	any sickness or contamination that results from the use of fresh
16	foods from the school garden, except when the sickness or
17	contamination is caused by a condition resulting from the
