## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 356D-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

15		of ten per cent or more as certified by the United
16		States Department of Veterans Affairs, the dependent
17		parents of the veteran, and the deceased veteran's

	regulations, the authority shall include the value of
	all motor vehicles registered to any tenant of a

### Report Title:

Public Housing Authority; Eligibility; Motor Vehicles

#### Description:

In determining eligibility for state low-income housing, requires that the value of all motor vehicles registered to any tenant be included when determining whether the tenant's annual net income and assets are within established maximum limits for housing eligibility. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB532 HD2)
