### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address campaign
 finance reform.

3 More specifically, this Act requires "super PACs" 4 (political action committees), meaning those noncandidate 5 committees that may raise and spend unlimited funds to influence 6 elections independently of candidate campaigns and political parties, to file two additional campaign reports. 7 The additional reports will ensure the disclosure of late 8 9 contributions of any amount that a "super PAC" receives as late 10 as four days prior to an election. The legislature finds that 11 this Act promotes transparency in the campaign process by 12 allowing voters to better determine the candidates who are 13 supported or opposed by "super PACs", many of which are funded 14 by special interests.

15 SECTION 2. Section 11-335, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
