A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the 1978
 constitutional convention believed that "public officers and
- 3 employees must exhibit the highest standards of ethical conduct
- 4 and that these standards come from the personal integrity of
- 5 each individual in government." Thereafter the legislature
- 6 established standards of ethical conduct for legislators and
- 7 employees by enactment of chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 8 These standards seek to preserve the public's confidence in the
- 9 actions and integrity of the Legislature.
- 10 However, conflicts of interest, and the appearance of
- 11 conflicts of interest, may arise when individuals who intern or
- 12 volunteer in a legislator's office receive compensation from a
- 13 private employer or entity.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to advance the public trust by
- 15 increasing government transparency and accountability by
- 16 restricting individuals from receiving privately-funded
- 17 compensation for interning or volunteering with the legislature.

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§84- Legislative interns; compensation from private
- 5 employers and other private entities. No person shall receive
- 6 any compensation from a private employer or other private entity
- 7 for the person's internship with the legislature; provided that
- 8 compensation from a private university or school shall be
- 9 permitted if the person is a student of the university or school
- 10 and receives academic credit for the internship.
- 11 For the purposes of this section, "internship" shall mean
- 12 any work, including volunteer work, performed for the
- 13 legislature by an individual who is not an employee of the
- 14 State."
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
- 18 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
