BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) There is established within the department	
2	of busine	ss, economic development, and tourism, for	
3	administr	ative purposes, a working group to study and consider	
4	ways to reduce the time and cost of shipping goods to Oahu from		
5	Molokai,	Lanai, and Hana, Maui and to recommend solutions.	
6	(b)	The working group shall consider strategies for	
7	reducing	the time and cost of shipping, including:	
8	(1)	Amending any existing statute, administrative rule, or	
9		ordinance;	
10	(2)	The feasibility of alternative modes of transportation	
11		or other means of shipping freight between islands;	
12	(3)	Reducing taxes;	
13	(4)	Creating tax incentives; and	
14	(5)	Any other issues the working group considers	
15		appropriate.	
16	(c)	The working group shall comprise the following

2		tourism or the director's designee;
3	(2)	The director of transportation or the director's

5	(3)	The director of taxation or the director's designee;

8	(5)	A county official from the county of Maui, or the
9		county official's designee, to be appointed by the
10		mayor of the county of Maui;
11	(6)	A representative from the shipping industry, to be
12		appointed by the speaker of the house of
13		representatives;

15		appointed by the president of the senate;
16	(8)	A member representing the island of Molokai appointed

(d) The members of the working group shall designate a
 chairperson from among their members and shall serve without
 compensation, but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses,
 including travel expenses, incurred in the performance of
 official duties.

6 (e) The department of business, economic development, and7 tourism shall provide all administrative, technical,

8 professional, and clerical support required by the working group9 for matters pertaining to this Act.

10 (f) No member of the working group shall be made subject
11 to chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of that
12 member's participation as a member of the working group.

(g) The working group shall report to the legislature its
findings and recommendations, including any proposed
legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
the regular session of 2014.

17 (h) The working group shall cease to exist on June 30,18 2014.

19 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for
