- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation shall

- 4 (b) The department shall also study the potential dangers
- 5 involved and any precautionary measures needed for emergency
- 6 personnel that respond to emergency situations involving
- 7 electric vehicles.
- 8 (c) The department shall submit a report of its findings
- 9 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 10 legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of
- 11 the regular session of 2014.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 to study
- 15 and develop a training program regarding the potential risks
- 16 involved and precautionary measures needed for emergency
- 17 personnel who are called to emergency situations involving an
- 18 electric vehicle.
