# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTIO	N 1.	Section	279E-3,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is
2	amended to	read	as follow	vs:				

3 "§279E-3 Metropolitan Planning Organization membership.
4 The MPO shall consist of a policy committee and appropriate
5 staff. The MPO policy committee shall consist of [thirteen]
6 fourteen members. These members shall include:

- 7 (1) Five members of the legislative body of the8 appropriate county;
- 9 (2) Three members of the state senate:

10 One of whom shall be chairperson of the senate (A) 11 committee with primary responsibility for 12 transportation issues. In the event there is 13 more than one chairperson of the senate committee with primary responsibility for transportation 14 15 issues, the senate president shall identify the 16 chairperson who shall serve on the MPO policy 17 committee and who shall not be required to be a 18 resident of the appropriate county; and



1		(B) Two of whom shall be residents of the appropriate
2		county and shall be appointed by the senate
3		president;
4	(3)	Three members of the state house of representatives:
5		(A) One of whom shall be the chairperson of the
6		committee of the house of representatives with
7		primary responsibility for transportation issues;
8		and
9		(B) Two of whom shall be residents of the appropriate
10		county and shall be appointed by the speaker of
11		the house;
12	(4)	One member who shall be the director of
13		transportation; [and]
14	(5)	One member who shall be the director of the
15		appropriate county department assigned primary
16		responsibility for transportation planning[-]; and
17	<u>(6)</u>	One member who shall be the director of the authority
18		for rapid or mass transportation, or successor agency
19		thereof that operates public transportation on the
20		relevant island.
21	Each	member of the MPO policy committee who is a member of
22	the state	legislature or the legislative body of the county



1 shall serve for the same term as the term of office for which 2 the member is elected. There shall be no remuneration for this 3 service. 4 Vacancies in the MPO policy committee that occur shall be 5 filled in the same manner in which the original member was 6 appointed." 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
