

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 60, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended 1 by amending section 6 to read as follows: 2 "SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon approval, 3 4 provided that: Section 2 shall apply to taxable years beginning after 5 (1) December 31, 2008[+], and shall be repealed on 6 December 31, 2014; provided that section 235-51(a), 7 (b), and (c), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be 8 9 reenacted in the form in which it read on the day 10 before the effective date of this Act; (2) Sections 1 and 3 shall apply to taxable years 11 12 beginning after December 31, 2010; and (3) On December 31, 2015, this Act shall be repealed and 13 14 sections 235-2.4(a) $\left[\frac{-235-51(a)}{-235-51(a)}, \frac{(b)}{-235-51(a)}\right]$ and 235-54(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted 15 in the form in which they read on the day before the 16 effective date of this Act." 17

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
