#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Veterans donation check-off authorized. When 5 submitting an application for or renewal of a certificate of 6 registration, the applicant may designate \$1 or \$5 to be deposited into the veterans services special fund established by 7 8 section 363- . The director shall revise the application form 9 to allow the designation of contributions to the special fund on 10 the face of the application form. A designation, once made, may 11 not be revoked." SECTION 2. Chapter 363, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 14 15 "\$363- Veterans services special fund; established.

(a) There is established in the state treasury the veterans

services special fund, into which shall be deposited:
