RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the construction of		
2	a shared-use (bicycle and pedestrian) pathway along Kahekili		
3	highway between East Hui Iwa street and Waihee road would		
4	improve the quality of life of Kahaluu residents by helping to		
5	promote healthy lifestyles and providing safe, environmentally		
6	friendly, non-motor vehicle travel options for residents to		
7	commute to nearby parks, schools, and convenience stores.		
8	SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue		
9	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much		
10	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof		
11	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015		
12	for the planning, design, and construction of a shared-use		
13	pathway, allowing for two-directional bicycle and pedestrian		
14	traffic, along the mauka side of Kahekili highway between East		
15	Hui Iwa street and Waihee road on the island of Oahu. The sum
