### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 249-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

  "\$249-31 State registration fee. (a) All vehicles and motor vehicles in the State as defined in section 249-1,
- 5 [ $\frac{\text{including}}{\text{except}}$ ]  $\frac{\text{except}}{\text{except}}$  antique motor vehicles[ $\tau$ ] which shall be
- 6 subject to a \$25 annual vehicle registration fee, and except as
- 7 otherwise provided in sections 249-4 and 249-6, shall be subject
- $8\,$  to a \$45 annual vehicle registration fee. The fee shall be paid
- $oldsymbol{9}$  each year together with all other taxes and fees levied by this
- 10 chapter on a staggered basis as established by each county as
- 11 authorized by section 286-51, and the state registration for
- 12 that county shall likewise be staggered so that the state
- 13 registration fee is due and payable at the same time and shall
- 14 be collected together with the county fee. The state
- 15 registration fee shall be deemed delinquent if not paid with the
- 16 county registration fee. The respective counties shall collect
- 17 this fee together with the vehicle registration tax collected

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- 1 for the county and shall transfer the moneys collected under
- 2 this section to the State.
- 3 (b) From each annual motor vehicle registration fee,
- 4 except for the registration of an antique motor vehicle, the
- 5 director shall deposit \$40 into the state highway fund and \$5
- 6 into the emergency medical services special fund. In the case
- 7 of an antique motor vehicle registration fee, the director shall
- 8 deposit \$20 into the state highway fund and \$5 into the
- 9 emergency medical services special fund."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 249-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) All vehicles and motor vehicles in the State as
- 13 defined in section 249-1, including antique motor vehicles,
- 14 except as otherwise provided in sections 249-4, 249-5.5, 249-6,
- 15 and 249-6.5, in addition to all other fees and taxes levied by
- 16 this chapter, shall be subject to an annual state vehicle weight
- 17 tax. The tax shall be levied by the county director of finance
- 18 at the rate of 1.75 cents a pound, except for antique motor
- 19 vehicles which shall be taxed at the rate of 1.00 cent a pound,
- 20 according to the net weight of each vehicle as the "net weight"
- 21 is defined in section 249-1 up to and including four thousand
- 22 pounds net weight; vehicles over four thousand pounds and up to



- 1 and including seven thousand pounds net weight shall be taxed at
- 2 the rate of 2.00 cents a pound; vehicles over seven thousand
- 3 pounds and up to and including ten thousand pounds net weight
- 4 shall be taxed at the rate of 2.25 cents a pound; vehicles over
- ten thousand pounds net weight shall be taxed at a flat rate of 5
- \$300." 6
- 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
