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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 326, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
2	amended by amending section 2 to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 2. Chapter 237D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
5	and to read as follows:
6	"§237D- Local contact; relevant information;
7	advertisements; transient accommodations. (a) Any operator of
8	a transient accommodation shall designate a local contact
9	residing on the same island where the transient accommodation is
10	located.
11	(b) The operator shall furnish the name, address, and
12	contact information of the local contact to any association of
13	homeowners, community association, condominium association,
14	cooperative, or any other nongovernmental entity with covenants,
15	bylaws, and administrative provisions with which the operator's
16	compliance is required for the property where the transient
17	accommodation is located. The operator shall notify and provide
18	updated information to that association or nongovernmental
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1 entity within sixty calendar days of any change in the name, 2 address, and contact information of the local contact. Any person or entity who wilfully fails to supply 3 4 information required under this subsection shall [be subject to 5 the penalties under section 231-35; provided that a person or 6 entity shall not be subject to any term of imprisonment or 7 probation under section 231-35.] pay a civil penalty of \$1,000; 8 provided that the penalty shall be imposed no more than once per 9 year. 10 (c) Any nongovernmental entity with covenants, bylaws, and 11 administrative provisions which is formed pursuant to chapter 12 514A, 514B, or 421J, shall provide the department with all relevant information, maintained in its records, related to all 13 14 operators who may be leasing their property as transient 15 accommodations by December 31 of each year, or within sixty 16 calendar days of any change in the relevant information, 17 operation, or ownership of the transient accommodation. Any 18 person or entity who wilfully fails to supply information 19 required under this subsection shall [be subject to the penalties under section 231-35; provided that a person or entity 20 21 shall not be subject to any term of imprisonment or probation

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under section 231-35.] pay a civil penalty of \$1,000; provided 1 2 that the penalty shall be imposed no more than once per year. 3 Each county shall provide the department with (d) 4 information necessary to enforce this section. Notwithstanding 5 any provision of title 14 to the contrary, the department shall 6 provide the counties with information necessary for the 7 enforcement of county real property tax laws. 8 The name and phone number of the local contact for (e) 9 each transient accommodation shall be included in any transient 10 accommodation contract or written rental agreement and shall be 11 prominently posted in the transient accommodation. The local 12 contact shall reside on the same island as the transient 13 accommodation, and shall meet all other requirements under 14 subsection (a). Any person or entity who wilfully fails to 15 supply information required under this subsection shall [be 16 subject to the penalties under section 231-35; provided that -a 17 person or entity shall not be subject to any term of 18 imprisonment or probation under section 231-35.] pay a civil 19 penalty of \$1,000; provided that the penalty shall be imposed no 20. more than once per year. 21 The registration identification number issued pursuant (f)

22 to section 237D-4 shall be provided on a website or by online

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1 link and displayed in all advertisements and solicitations on 2 websites regarding transient accommodations for which the 3 registration number is issued. 4 (q) The payment of any penalty assessed under this section 5 shall be in addition to the requirements under section 237D-9. 6 (h) For the purposes of this section: 7 "Local contact" means an individual or company contracted 8 by the operator of the transient accommodation to provide 9 services required by this section. Nothing in this section 10 shall be deemed to create an employer-employee relationship 11 between an operator and its local contact. 12 "Relevant information" means the operator's name, address, 13 contact information, registration identification number issued 14 pursuant to section 237D-4, and website address if advertising 15 or soliciting the transient accommodation on the Internet."" 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to repealed is bracketed and 17 stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
