A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATUROPATHIC PHYSICIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that naturopathic 2 physicians are known for their expertise in bio-identical 3 hormone replacement therapy. The legislature further finds that 4 naturopathic physicians have been trained in the evaluation, 5 assessment, and appropriate application of natural bio-identical 6 testosterone therapy for symptom relief of testosterone 7 deficiency. Naturopathic physicians also receive on-going training in bio-identical hormone therapy and medical updates on 8 9 the safe and effective use of natural testosterone through the Hawaii Society of Naturopathic Physicians and various national 10 11 medical conferences.

12 The legislature additionally finds that federal law 13 requires physicians prescribing testosterone to have a federal 14 Drug Enforcement Administration registration number.

15 Furthermore, the Hawaii Society of Naturopathic Physicians 16 supports a limited-use federal Drug Enforcement Administration 17 registration number that would permit naturopathic physicians to 18 legally prescribe natural testosterone.

11	federal Drug Enforcement Administration, a naturopathic
12	physician may register with the department of public safety
13	pursuant to section 329-33 and may obtain a current federal Drug
14	Enforcement Administration registration number; provided that
15	registration pursuant to section 329-33 shall limit a
16	naturopathic physician to the prescription and administration of
17	testosterone and shall not entitle a naturopathic physician to
18	prescribe or administer any other controlled substances included
19	in sections 329-14, 329-16, 329-18, 329-20, and 329-22."
20	SECTION 3. Section 329-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
21	amended as follows:

21	"Naturopathic medicine" means the practice of the art and
22	science of diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of disorders of

1 the body by support, stimulation, or both, of the natural 2 processes of the human body. The practice of naturopathic 3 medicine includes the prescription, administration, dispensing, and use of nutrition and food science, physical modalities, 4 manual manipulation, parenteral therapy, minor office 5 6 procedures, naturopathic formulary, hygiene and immunization, 7 contraceptive devices, common diagnostic procedures, and behavioral medicine of the type taught in education and training 8 9 at naturopathic medical colleges; provided that the use of 10 parenteral therapy and performance of minor office procedures 11 shall not be allowed until the board adopts rules in accordance 12 with chapter 91 pursuant to section 455-6[-]; provided further that the prescription or administration of testosterone shall be 13 allowed only if the testosterone is bio-identical and prescribed 14 or administered in accordance with federal and state law solely 15 16 for purposes of hormone replacement therapy." 17 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 18 19 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. $\mathbf{20}$
