HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONSIDER THE CHARGING OF REASONABLE LICENSING FEES TO HEALTHCARE FACILITIES.

1 2	WHEREAS, healthcare facilities represent a critical sector of Hawaii's health care industry; and
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4	WHEREAS, section 321-15.2 defines "healthcare facility" as
5	a facility or setting where a frail, elderly, or disabled adult
6	receives care or is provided living accommodations such as a
7	skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facility, adult
8	residential care home, expanded adult residential care home,
9	assisted living facility, home health agency, home care agency,
10	hospice, adult day health center, special treatment facility,
11 12	therapeutic living program, intermediate care facility for the
12	mentally retarded, hospital, rural health center, and rehabilitation agency; and
14	renabilitation agency; and
15	WHEREAS, it is expected that the Department of Health will
16	impose a licensing fee on healthcare facilities to fund the
17	administrative costs associated with home care licensing
18	requirements; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, licensing fees for healthcare facilities vary
21	widely from state to state, with some states not charging for
22	license applications and others charging thousands of dollars
23	regardless of the number of patients served; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, licensing fees in Hawaii could reach thousands of
26	dollars and create a significant barrier for any individual
27	desiring to enter into or remain in the selfless field of care-
28	giving, particularly for adult residential care homes, expanded
29	adult residential care homes; and
30	
31 32	WHEREAS, a licensing fee barrier to entering the healthcare facility field would limit the number of available home care



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agencies and harm the very people the licensing requirements 1 2 were enacted to protect; and 3 WHEREAS, any licensing fee would simply be passed to the 4 5 patients and, since many healthcare facility patients receive 6 government assistance to fund their care, any licensing fee 7 would just result in transferring money from one government 8 agency to another; and 9 10 WHEREAS, if healthcare facilities, particularly adult residential care homes, expanded adult residential care homes 11 are forced out of business, their patients will go to other 12 forms of health care providers, and, in turn, strain the State's 13 capacity to provide quality health care; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, many community organizations, such as the Filipino 17 Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii, have spoken against the 18 potentially devastating effects of a licensing fee on a 19 disproportionately large number of existing healthcare facilities, particularly adult residential care homes, expanded 20 adult residential care homes; now, therefore, 21 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 24 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 25 26 Health is urged to consider charging reasonable licensing fees 27 to healthcare facilities; and 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health. 30 31 32 33 34
