HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO STUDY THE CORRELATION BETWEEN SEXUAL ABUSE AND POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER WITHIN THE STATE'S FEMALE PRISON POPULATION.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety is responsible for 1 2 ensuring the safety of the State's prison population; and 3 4 WHEREAS, sexual attacks are a common occurrence in prisons 5 nationwide, prompting the need for the federal Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003, the purpose of which is to reduce 6 prison rape through research and information gathering; and 7 8 WHEREAS, victims of sexual assault may be less likely to 9 report the incident due to the fear of retaliation or the fear 10 of being stigmatized with pejorative labels; and 11 12 WHEREAS, female inmates who are victims of sexual assault 13 have limited resources and support networks to cope with the 14 experience, which further inhibits female inmates from reporting 15 the sexual assault; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the symptoms of sexual violence may include 18 intense fear, helplessness, or horror and may develop into post-19 traumatic stress disorder; and 20 21 WHEREAS, people who experience post-traumatic stress 22 disorder are often forced to rely on psychotherapy or 23 medications to help them cope with the causes and symptoms of 24 the disorder; now, therefore, 25 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 27 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 28 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 29

Public Safety is requested to conduct a study of the correlation 1 between sexual abuse and post-traumatic stress disorder within 2 the female inmate population; and 3 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED than any information gathered as part of this study pertaining to individual names or 6 identifications shall be kept confidential at all times; and 7 -8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Public Safety is requested to report findings and recommendations to the 10 Legislature not later than twenty days before the convening of 11 the 2015 Regular Session; and 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Public 15 Safety and the Director of Health. 16 17 18 19
