8 9 10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, the Hawaii Food and Wine Festival began twenty years later in 2011 with more than eighty chefs from all over the world coming together to showcase Hawaii's incredible bounty of fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, beef, eggs, fish, pork, coffee, honey, and more; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the festival is a testament to the impact that Hawaii Regional Cuisine chefs and local farmers have had upon Hawaii's culinary arts and its agricultural industry; and
19 20 21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, the festival moves Hawaii regional cuisine forward by bringing together tourism, education, culture, environmentalism, and sustainability to ensure that Hawaii maintains a healthy and vibrant economy for future generations; and
