## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING ALL AIR CARRIERS THAT FLY INTERISLAND ROUTES IN HAWAII TO WAIVE ANY BAGGAGE FEE FOR A PASSENGER'S FIRST CHECKED BAG ON AN INTERISLAND FLIGHT.

WHEREAS, ensuring the safety of passengers who travel by 1 air is critically important; and 2 3 WHEREAS, to help pay for providing security services, the 4 federal Transportation Security Administration has implemented 5 security fees approved by Congress; and 6 . 7 WHEREAS, making air travel as affordable as possible is 8 also important; and 9 10 WHEREAS, some air carriers have begun charging passengers a 11 fee for each piece of checked baggage; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, at the same time rising fuel costs have contributed to higher airfares; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the combination of higher fares and security and 17 baggage fees has drastically increased the cost of interisland 18 travel for many Hawaii residents and visitors; and 19 20 WHEREAS, flying is the only practical way for most 21 passengers to travel among the islands to visit family and 22 friends, conduct business, pursue educational opportunities, and 23 enjoy all that Hawaii has to offer; and 24 25 WHEREAS, charging passengers for each piece of checked 26 27 baggage could discourage interisland travel and make it prohibitively expensive for some passengers; and 28 29 WHEREAS, it is reasonable to allow each air passenger to 30 bring one piece of checked baggage without charging an 31 additional fee; now, therefore, 32 33

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2014, that all air carriers flying interisland routes in the State of Hawaii are urged to waive or refrain from imposing and collecting any fee for a passenger's first piece of checked baggage on any flight between islands in Hawaii; and 7
