HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONVENE AND CHAIR A WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP THE MEANS TO ALLOW PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE HAIKU STAIRS AREA.

WHEREAS, in 1942, the United States Navy built a staircase, 1 which became known as the "Stairway to Heaven" or "Haiku Stairs" 2 (Stairs), as a means to access its transmission facilities at 3 the ridgeline of the Koolau Mountains above Haiku Valley; and 4 5 WHEREAS, in 1972, the transmission facilities were 6 transferred from the Navy to the United States Coast Guard for 7 operation of both LORAN and OMEGA navigational systems used by *8 ships crossing the Pacific Ocean; and 9 10 WHEREAS, after newer navigational systems were employed in 11 1987, the OMEGA station became obsolete and was shut down by the 12 Coast Guard, eventually leading to the disrepair of the Stairs, 13 and restricting access to the Stairs that had been granted to 14 hikers since 1982; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the area has not been officially opened to the public since 1987; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Stairs is composed of 3,922 steps that lead up 20 to the Koolau Pali and the summit of Puu Keahiakahoe that 21 overlooks Haiku Valley, and on a clear day the view at the top 22 includes most of Windward Oahu, Pearl Harbor, and parts of 23 Leeward Oahu; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the area has many miles of hiking trails, paved 26 roadways, a scenic climb to a lookout on the Koolau Mountains, 27 and many sites of historic, cultural, and archeological 28 significance; and 29

WHEREAS, the Stairs ascend through the cliffs and hillsides 1 of the Haiku Valley, which is inhabited by native plant species 2 3 and contains natural habitats for a number of native birds; and 4 WHEREAS, numerous public and private entities claim an 5 interest in the lands surrounding the Stairs; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, the area of the Stairs due to its historical, aesthetic, environmental, and recreational significance should 9 be open to the public; now, therefore, 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 12 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 13 14 Session of 2014, that the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, or the Chairperson's designee, is requested 15 to convene and chair a working group to develop the means to 16 allow public access to the Haiku Stairs area; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group include representatives from state and county agencies, community 20 organizations, and private entities and individuals, deemed 21 necessary by the Chairperson to achieve the purpose of this 22 Resolution; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson report the findings and recommendations of the working group, including any 26 necessary proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 27 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2015; 28 29 and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 32 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and the Mayor of the City 33 and County of Honolulu. 34 35 36 OFFERED BY: MAR 0 6 2014 37
