HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE USE OF HAWAII-BASED UNION CONTRACTORS AND WORKERS FOR STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY CONSTRUCTION OR RENOVATION PROJECTS.

1 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii is obligated to operate a system of correctional facilities to house those members of 2 society who have been convicted of crimes and must be 3 incarcerated for potential rehabilitation and to ensure the 4 safety of society; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the State's correctional facilities are in need of 7 repair and expansion; and 8 9 WHEREAS, most correctional facilities have reached or 10 exceeded their maximum prisoner capacities, and the State has 11 contracted with facilities in other states to hold Hawaii 12 inmates; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the State needs to construct additional 15 correctional facilities to hold Hawaii inmates who are currently 16 held in other states; and 17 18 WHEREAS, state officials have indicated a desire to bring 19 Hawaii inmates held in other states back to Hawaii; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the Governor has indicated that the State is 22 seeking public-private partnerships to build additional 23 correctional facilities; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the construction of any new correctional facility 26 on state land must comply with state procurement and contracting 27 laws and other state requirements; now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 30 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 31 Session of 2014, that for the construction or renovation of any 32 correctional facility in Hawaii, the state administration is 33 34 urged to require:
