A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KAPOLEI RECREATIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 109-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There shall be within the department of accounting
4	and general services for administrative purposes only, a stadium
5	authority whose responsibility shall be to maintain, operate,
6	and manage the stadium and facilities attached thereto [and to
7	provide for the maintenance, operation, management, and
8	promotion of the Kapolei recreational sports complex]. The
9	authority shall consist of nine members who shall be appointed
10	by the governor in the manner prescribed by section 26-34. Each
11	member of the authority shall have been a citizen of the United
12	States and a resident of the State for at least five years next
13	preceding the member's appointment. The president of the
14	University of Hawaii and the superintendent of education shall
15	be ex officio members of the authority but shall not vote."

SECTION 2. Section 109-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

amended to read as follows:

1	"§ 1 0	9-2 Stadium authority; powers and duties. The powers
2	and dutie	s of the stadium authority shall be as follows:
3	(1)	To maintain, operate, and manage the stadium and
4		related facilities[, and to provide for the
5		maintenance, operation, management, and promotion of
6		the Kapolei recreational sports complex];
7	(2)	To prescribe and collect rents, fees, and charges for
8		the use or enjoyment of the stadium or any of its
9		facilities;
10	(3)	To make and execute contracts and other instruments
11		necessary or convenient to exercise its powers under
12		this chapter and subject to any limitations in this
13		chapter, to exercise all powers necessary, incidental,
14		or convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes
15		and provisions of this chapter[, including entering
16		into contracts under chapter 102 or 103D for the
17		management of the Kapolei recreational sports complex,
18		to include but not be limited to the operation,
19		maintenance, and promotion of the complex in a manner
20		that is beneficial to both the State and the
21		contractor. These contracts may contain revenue

- (4) To adopt, amend, and repeal in accordance with chapter 91 rules it may deem necessary to effectuate this chapter and in connection with its projects, operations, and facilities;
- 7 (5) To appoint a manager and a deputy manager who shall 8 have such qualifications as the authority deems 9 necessary and who shall hold their respective offices 10 at the pleasure of the authority. The manager and 11 deputy manager shall be exempt from the requirements 12 of chapters 76 and 89. Effective July 1, 2005, the 13 manager shall be paid a salary not to exceed eighty-14 seven per cent of the salary of the director of human 15 resources development. Effective July 1, 2005, the 16 deputy manager shall be paid a salary not to exceed 17 eighty-five per cent of the manager's salary. The manager shall have full power to administer the 18 19 affairs of the stadium and related facilities, [and to 20 provide for a management contract for the Kapolei recreational sports complex, subject to the direction 21 22 and approval of the authority. The manager shall,
