A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYER UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide:

2 (1) Employer contribution amounts for plan years 2011-2012 3 and 2012-2013 for Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund health benefit plan premiums for the employees of collective bargaining unit (10) and 5 for state officers and employees excluded from 7 collective bargaining and belonging to the same 8 compensation plans as those officers and employees 9 within collective bargaining unit (10) pursuant to 10 section 89-11(g), Hawaii Revised Statutes, due to an 11 impasse in negotiations on issues involving the Hawaii 12 employer-union health benefits trust fund; and 13 (2) Employer plan contributions of a specific dollar 14 amount equivalent to fifty per cent of the premium 15 rates established by the board of trustees of the 16 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund for
