BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 165-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§165-4 Right to farm. No court, official, public 4 servant, or public employee shall declare any farming operation a nuisance for any reason if the farming operation has been 5 6 conducted in a manner consistent with generally accepted 7 agricultural and management practices. There shall be a 8 rebuttable presumption that a farming operation does not 9 constitute a nuisance. The right of farmers and ranchers to 10 engage in modern farming and ranching practices shall be forever 11 quaranteed in this State. No law, ordinance, or resolution of 12 any unit of local government shall be enacted that abridges the 13 right of farmers and ranchers to employ agricultural technology, 14 modern livestock production, and ranching practices not prohibited by federal or state law, rules, or regulations." 15 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
