## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 342G-82, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Every glass container importer shall pay to the
- 4 department an advance disposal fee. The fee shall be imposed
- 5 only once on the same glass container and shall not be assessed
- 6 on drinking glasses, cups, bowls, plates, ashtrays, and similar
- 7 tempered glass containers. For the period beginning [September
- 8 1, 1994, January 2, 2014, the fee shall be [one and one-half
- 9 cents per glass container. Beginning October 1, 2004, the] 3
- 10 cents per glass container containing twelve ounces or less
- 11 determined by weight or volume; and 6 cents per glass container
- 12 containing greater than twelve ounces determined by weight or
- 13 volume. The glass advance disposal fee shall only apply to
- 14 glass containers that are not glass deposit beverage
- 15 containers."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
2 on January 1, 2014.
