- 5 sections 115-5, 115-9, and 205A-2(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 6 shall be reenacted in the form in which they read one day prior
- 7 to the effective date of this Act]."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
