A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWENTY-FIFTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$42,065,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5	for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
6	fifth senatorial district, as follows:
7	1. To be expended by the department of transportation:

17	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective			
18	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be			
19	expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of			
20	this Act.
