BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Chapter 440J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the title to read as follows: 3 "[f]CHAPTER 440J[1] 4 TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND CABLE INDUSTRY [INFORMATION REPORTING] " 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 440J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 7 and to read as follows: 8 "§440J- Fiber optic cable system required for new 9 single-family and duplex residential construction. (a) On or 10 after January 1, 2014, no building permit shall be issued for a 11 new single-family, duplex, condominium, or apartment dwelling 12 that does not include a fiber optic cable system that meets the 13 standards established pursuant to subsection (c). 14 (b) Nothing in this section shall preclude any county from 15 establishing procedures and standards required to implement this 16 section. (c) Not later than December 31, 2013, the director shall
