## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 156, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, section 2 2, is amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (c) of section -4, Hawaii

- 5 "(c) Revenue from the nursing facility sustainability fee
- 6 shall be used exclusively as follows:
- 10 No less than eighty-eight per cent of the revenue from the nursing facility sustainability fee shall be used to match federal medicaid funds, with the combined total to be used to enhance capitated rates to the QUEST expanded access plans for the purpose of increasing medicaid payments to private nursing facilities;
- 14 (2) Twelve per cent of the revenue from the nursing

### Report Title:
