A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 444, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§444- Licensing; power of board to accept equivalent
5	knowledge. The board in its discretion may accept any
6	reasonably equivalent knowledge, training, or experience of the
7	applicant for a license in lieu of a specific experience
8	requirement, including self-employed or unlicensed experience,
9	if upon investigation and verification, the board makes a
10	detailed written finding to that effect and the written finding
11	is made available for public inspection."
12	SECTION 2. Section 444-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
14	"(a) No license hereunder shall be issued to:
15	(1) Any person unless the person has filed an application
16	and paid the applicable fees;
17	(2) Any person unless the person meets the experience

(2) Any person unless the person meets the experience requirements as prescribed in the board's rules;

2		[acquired on a self-employed or unlicensed basis if
3		the experience can be verified; as provided in

5	(3)	Any person who does not possess a history of honesty,
6		truthfulness, financial integrity, and fair dealing;
7		provided that any person who during the six years
8		prior to application has failed to satisfy an
9		undisputed debt or a judgment relating to services or
10		materials rendered in connection with operations as a
11		contractor shall be presumed not to possess a history
12		of financial integrity;
13	(4)	Any person unless the person has successfully passed a
14		written examination as prescribed by the board;
15	(5)	Any individual unless the individual is age eighteen
16		years or more;
17	(6)	Any joint venture [which] that is not exempt under
18		section 444-2(8) unless the contracting business
19		thereof is under the direct management of a member or
20		employee thereof, and unless the member or employee
21		holds an appropriate license;

1	(7)	Any individual who is unable to qualify as a
2		contractor or any partnership or corporation, unless
3		the contracting business of the individual,
4		partnership, or corporation is under the direct
5		management of an employee, partner, or officer thereof
6		who holds an appropriate license;
7	(8)	Any person unless the person submits satisfactory
8		proof to the board that the person has obtained
9		workers' compensation insurance, or has been
10		authorized to act as a self-insurer under chapter 386
11		or is excluded from the requirements of chapter 386;
12	(9)	Any person unless the person submits satisfactory
13		proof to the board that the person has obtained
14		liability insurance; or
15	(10)	Any person unless the person submits a bond if
16		required by the board under section 444-16.5."
