A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KAHO'OLAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to grant the 2 Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission a permanent exemption from chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the procurement of 3 food or fuel products necessary for the commission to carry out 4 5 the purposes of chapter 6K, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 6 SECTION 2. Act 159, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is 7 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows: 8 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010; 9 provided that the amendment made to section 103D-102(c), Hawaii 10 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed when section 11 103D-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted on July 1, 2012, 12 by section 14 of Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009[; provided
- 13 further that this Act shall be repealed on July 1, 2013; and
- 14 provided further that, on July 1, 2013, section 103D-102, Hawaii
- 15 Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which it
- 16 read on the day before the effective date of Act 175, Session
- 17 Laws of Hawaii 2009]."

- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
