RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 302D-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) Charter schools shall be exempt from chapters 91 and 3 4 92 and all other state laws in conflict with this chapter, 5 except those regarding: Collective bargaining under chapter 89; provided that: 6 (1) The exclusive representatives as defined in 7 (A) chapter 89 and the governing board of the charter 8 school may enter into either supplemental 9 10 agreements that contain cost and noncost items to facilitate decentralized decision-making[+] or 11 12 master agreements separate from any other master 13 agreement collectively bargained for between the 14 exclusive representatives and department, as 15 defined in chapter 89; The agreements shall be funded from the current 16 (B) allocation or other sources of revenue received 17 by the charter school; provided that collective 18
