### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 444-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: This chapter shall not apply to owners or lessees of 3 property who build or improve residential, farm, industrial, or 4 commercial buildings or structures on property for their own 5 use, or for use by their grandparents, parents, siblings, or 6 children and who do not offer the buildings or structures for 7 8 sale or lease; provided that: 9 (1)To qualify for an exemption under this section, the owner or lessee shall register for the exemption as 10 provided in section 444-9.1; and 11 12 (2) The exemption under this section shall not apply to 13 electrical [or] work, plumbing work, plumber air conditioning and refrigeration pipefitter work, or 14 plumber fire sprinkler pipefitter work, that must be 15 16 performed only by persons or entities licensed in accordance with this chapter, unless the owner or 17

1 lessee of the property is licensed for such work under 2 chapter 448E." SECTION 2. Section 444-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 4 amended to read as follows: 5 "§444-9.5 Licensing of electrical or plumbing workers. Excludes certain work from the owner-builder licensing exemption. Increases the percentage of licensed individuals on a job necessary to perform certain work. Effective 07/01/2015.
