RELATING TO FISHING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 188, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is							
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated							
3	and to read as follows:							
4	"§188- Parrot fish; prohibitions, penalties, and fines.							
5	(a) Effective July 1, 2014, no person shall knowingly capture							
6	or kill any parrot fish within state marine waters.							
7	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), any person who holds a							
8	license or permit issued by the department of land and natural							
9	resources to conduct research or for educational purposes							
10	possesses, sells, offers for sale, trades, or distributes parrot							
11	fish shall not be subject to the penalties of this section.							
12	(c) Any person violating this section or rule adopted							
13	pursuant to this section shall be penalized as follows:							
14	(1) For a first offense, by an administrative fine of not							
15	less than \$1,000 and not more than \$3,000;							
16	(2) For a second offense, by an administrative fine of not							
17	less than \$3,000 and not more than \$10,000. In							
18	addition, parrot fish, commercial marine licenses,

3		seizure and forfeiture pursuant to chapter 712A; and
4	(3)	For a third or subsequent offense, by an

10		of this section shall be subject to seizure and
