BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "\$237- Exemption for farmers of fresh farm produce. (a) 5 This chapter shall not apply to amounts received by a farmer for the sale of fresh farm produce that is intended for human 6 7 consumption within the State; provided that farmers shall have 8 registered with the department of taxation by filling out a 9 written application for registration in such form as the 10 department of taxation shall prescribe, shall have paid a 11 registration fee of \$ and annually thereafter, and 12 shall have had the exemption approved by the department of 13 taxation. 14 This exemption shall not apply to sales of fresh farm 15 produce intended for human consumption abroad.
