A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In 2011, the North Hawaii Community Hospital
- 2 established the Kaheleaulani Native Hawaiian health program to
- 3 address the unmet medical needs of the Native Hawaiian
- 4 population of north Hawaii. The program currently operates out
- 5 of the North Hawaii Community Hospital.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the issuance of
- 7 general obligation bonds and appropriate funds for the planning,
- 8 design, and construction of a new health care facility for the
- 9 Kaheleaulani Native Hawaiian health program.
- 10 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 11 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$7,800,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
- 14 for the planning, design, and construction of a new health care
- 15 facility for the Kaheleaulani Native Hawaiian health program in
- 16 Waimea on the island of Hawaii.
- 17 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 18 department of health for the purposes of this Act.

3	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
