A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a center providing 2 comprehensive services for deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind 3 individuals in Hawaii has been the dream of the deaf community 4 in Hawaii since 1972. The creation of a comprehensive service 5 center is intended to promote individual growth, social awareness, productivity, and equality by empowering deaf, hard 6 7 of hearing, and deaf-blind persons to be full participants in 8 Hawaii's overall community. 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 10 department of human services for the establishment and operation 11 of a comprehensive service center for the deaf, hard of hearing,

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the establishment and operation of a comprehensive
