## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are currently
- 2 hundreds of individuals on the island of Oahu that are at risk
- 3 of losing necessary long-term care services due to recent
- 4 funding changes. Prior to November 2013, long-term care
- 5 services needed by aging and disabled medicaid beneficiaries
- 6 were paid for by kupuna care or federal Older Americans Act
- 7 funds. Long-term care services include personal care, attendant
- 8 care, congregate meals, home delivered meals, assisted
- 9 transportation, and kupuna care transportation. As of November
- 10 2013, long-term care services for medicaid beneficiaries are no
- 11 longer covered by kupuna care or Older Americans Act funds.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 13 department of human services so that aging and disabled
- 14 individuals on medicaid can continue to receive necessary long-
- 15 term care services.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 1 necessary long-term care services for aging and disabled
- 2 individuals on medicaid; provided that the sum appropriated
- 3 shall be in addition to the base budget of the department of
- 4 human services.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
