## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL MEALS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that childhood obesity SECTION 1. continues to be a problem in the State. In Hawaii, childhood 2
- obesity increased by thirty-eight per cent between 1999 and 3
- 4 2009. As a result of health risks and complications related to
- 5 obesity, the current generation of children may be the first
- 6 generation not to outlive their parents. Obesity-related
- 7 medical expenditures in Hawaii were calculated to be over
- 8 \$470,000,000 in 2009 and are continuing to increase.
- 9 The legislature further finds that healthy eating and
- 10 physical exercise can help reduce childhood obesity. Therefore,
- efforts to promote healthy eating and physical activity among 11
- 12 children are absolutely critical. Some jurisdictions have
- enacted laws requiring that restaurants and fast food chains 13
- 14 display nutritional information on their menus to allow
- 15 customers to make informed decisions about what they order.
- 16 legislature believes that parents and students should be
- 17 provided the same opportunity to make informed decisions about
- 18 what students eat during school hours.



1 The purpose of this Act is to require all public schools 2 that disseminate school meal menus online or in printed form to 3 include certain nutritional information with each menu. SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 6 and to read as follows: 7 "§302A- School meals; nutritional information. 8 schools that regularly disseminate school meal menus online or 9 in printed form shall include with each menu information on the 10 nutritional content of each school meal listed, including the 11 total number of: 12 (1) Grams of saturated fat; 13 (2) Grams of protein; 14 (3) Grams of carbohydrates; 15 (4) Milligrams of sodium; and 16 (5) Calories." 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2015. 19 INTRODUCED BY:
