A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 328J-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The sale or distribution at no charge of cigarettes
4	by the fo	llowing methods is prohibited:
5	(1)	From cigarette vending machines unless the vending
6		machine is located in a bar, cabaret, or any
7		establishment for which the minimum age for admission
8		is [eighteen;] <u>twenty-one;</u> or
9	(2)	From a lunch wagon engaging in any sales activity
10		within one thousand feet of any public or private
11		elementary or secondary school grounds."
12	SECT	ION 2. Section 328J-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by	y amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
14	"(C)	This section shall not apply:
15	(1)	Within private commercial establishments, such as
16		stores and restaurants, where tobacco products are
17		sold, as long as distribution is not visible to the
18		public from outside the establishment; or

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1	(2) To commercial establishments where access to the	
2	premises by persons under [eighteen] twenty-one years	
3	of age is prohibited by law."	
4	SECTION 3. Section 328J-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
5	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
6	"(b) This section shall not apply to:	
7	(1) A duty-free sales enterprise selling duty-free	
8	merchandise in accordance with the provisions of Title	
9	19 United States Code section 1555(b), and any	
10	implementing regulations; and	
11	(2) Retail tobacco stores, bars, or any other	
12	establishment for which the minimum age for admission	
13	is [eighteen.] <u>twenty-one.</u> "	
14	SECTION 4. Section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
15	amended to read as follows:	
16	"§709-908 Tobacco and electronic smoking devices	
17	prohibited; [minors.]; persons under twenty-one years of age.	
18	(1) It shall be unlawful to sell or furnish tobacco in any	
19	shape or form, including chewing tobacco and snuff, or an	
20	electronic smoking device to a [minor] person under [eighteen]	
21	twenty-one years of age.	

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(2) Signs using the statement, "The sale of tobacco 1 2 products or electronic smoking devices to persons under 3 [eighteen] twenty-one is prohibited", shall be posted on or near 4 any vending machine in letters at least one-half inch high and 5 at or near the point of sale of any other location where tobacco 6 products or electronic smoking devices are sold in letters at 7 least one-half inch high. 8 (3) It shall be unlawful for a [minor] person under 9 [eighteen] twenty-one years of age to purchase any tobacco 10 product, as described under subsection (1), or an electronic 11 smoking device, as described under subsection (5). This 12 provision does not apply if a person under the age of 13 $[\frac{\text{cighteen}_{7}}{\text{cighteen}_{7}}]$ twenty-one, and with parental authorization $[\frac{1}{7}]$ if 14 under the age of eighteen, is participating in a controlled 15 purchase as part of a law enforcement activity or a study 16 authorized by the department of health under the supervision of 17 law enforcement to determine the level of incidence of tobacco 18 or electronic smoking devices sales to [minors.] persons under 19 the age of twenty-one. 20 (4) Any person who violates subsection (1) or (2), or 21 both, shall be fined \$500 for the first offense. Any subsequent

offenses shall subject the person to a fine not less than \$500

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- 1 nor more than \$2,000. Any [minor] person under [eighteen]
- 2 twenty-one years of age who violates subsection (3) shall be
- 3 fined \$10 for the first offense. Any subsequent offense shall
- 4 subject the violator to a fine of \$50, no part of which shall be
- 5 suspended, or the person shall be required to perform not less
- 6 than forty-eight hours nor more than seventy-two hours of
- 7 community service during hours when the person is not employed
- 8 and is not attending school.
- 9 (5) For the purposes of this section:
- 10 "Electronic smoking device" means any electronic product
- 11 that can be used to simulate smoking in the delivery of nicotine
- 12 or other substances to the person inhaling from the device,
- 13 including but not limited to an electronic cigarette, electronic
- 14 cigar, electronic cigarillo, or electronic pipe, and any
- 15 cartridge or other component of the device or related product."
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 18 begun before its effective date.
- 19 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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1 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
